

Alabama Department of Education Third Party Routine Data Send Feeds

Chalkable, formerly STI (Software Technology, Inc.): Statewide student management system. Chalkable PD, I-LIVE, I-NOW, Chalkable SETS WEB, Chalkable Health Management System are programs that are part of the system. Currently course code files and child nutrition eligibility are sent to all school districts' iNOW system.

AHSAA (C2C): Schedules, courses, and grades to help determine eligibility (Requires schools to obtain parent permission on athletic form before checking athletic box in iNOW.)

D2L, Ltd (Desire to Learn): Online learning management system for ACCESS Distance Learning. Student enrollment data from iLIVE are sent to D2L.

ACT: Student enrollment data are sent to ACT to create labels for tests booklets and construct data sets for student test result to be sent to the ALSDE and LEAs for statewide testing of ACT Aspire, ACT Explore, ACT Plan, ACT Plus Writing, ACT WorkKeys, and Quality Core EOC.

Scantron (Global Scholar): On-Line formative assessment tool for students. Enrollment data are sent to Scantron for student matching to ensure test data is connected to the appropriate students and schools.

Kuder: Alabama Career Planning System. Enrollment, schedules, and valid courses are sent to Kuder to match up students for the input of their four year plans.

CSPR/IDEA/EDEN: Federal Reporting – all reporting required by and sent to the U.S. Department of Education. Aggregate level data only.

ELPP: Early Learning Progress Profile (ELPP) online data collection system. Student enrollment data are sent to Auburn Transition and Leadership Institute (ATLI) that maintains and compiles the (ELPP) online data collection system. This data collection is required to meet Indicator 7 federal reporting requirements regarding the education of preschool children with disabilities [20 U.S.C. 1418(a) (3) (a)].

Auburn University - Post School Surveys: For youth who are no longer in secondary school and had Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) in effect at the time they left school, a sample of school systems each year conduct the Alabama Post-School Outcomes Survey through telephone surveys with exited youth or a knowledgeable person (e.g., parent or relative). The completed data sets are sent to Auburn for analysis and Auburn provides the results to the ALSDE for reporting purposes. This data is required through Indicator 14 of the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report requirement at *(20 USC 1416(a) (3) (B))*.

Auburn University - Alabama Parent Survey: In order to comply with the requirement under Indicator 8 of the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report, parents of children with IEPs in a sample of school systems are asked to respond to a survey each

year. The parent address labels are sent to Auburn University to process the parent survey mail-outs. Auburn University analyzes the survey data and provides it to the ALSDE for reporting purposes. This data is required to be submitted to the USDE under *(20 USC 1416(a) (3) (A))*.

EGap: Electronic grant allocation program which provides for the disbursement of federal grant monies to each LEA.

Payment Processing Alabama Interactive Teacher: Licensure Applications and Renewals

National Association of State Directors of Teacher Education and Certification (NASDTEC) Clearinghouse: An Educator Identification Clearinghouse which allows licensing agencies to exchange names of educators whose certificate, licenses or similar credentials authorizing them to engage in school professions have been denied, revoked, suspended, surrendered or otherwise adversely acted upon.

Other State Agencies: Alabama SuperComputer Authority, Alabama Department of Finance, Alabama Department of Children's Affairs, Alabama Commission on Higher Education, and Alabama Department of Public Safety.
