About CACFP Online Application

What does it do?

The Child Nutrition Program (CNP) Online Application is a web based application designed to allow CNP participants to submit their yearly applications for participation and monthly site data sheets to the Department of Education for review and approval.

The USDA Child and Adult Care Food Program plays a vital role in improving the quality of food for adult care and day care centers as well as emergency shelters and snacks and suppers to youths participating in eligible afterschool care programs.

- CACFP → Applications: Displays the Sponsor, Facility, and Budget applications that must be submitted yearly by sponsors for participation in the USDA Child and Adult Care Program.
- CACFP → Applications→Site Data: Displays the reimbursement request that must be submitted for each month the sponsor operated the program.
