About NSLP Online Application

What does it do?

The Child Nutrition Program (CNP) Online Application is a web based application designed to allow CNP participants to submit their yearly applications for participation and monthly site data sheets to the Department of Education for review and approval.

The National School Lunch Program (NSLP) is a federally assisted meal program operating in public and nonprofit private schools and residential child care institutions. It provides nutritionally balanced, low-cost or free lunches to children each school day.

- NSLP → Forms: Displays the Policy Checklist, Schedule A, SFA Officials and Collection Procedures applications that must be submitted yearly by all Public Schools, Private Schools and Residential Child Care Institutions for participation in the USDA National School Lunch Program.
- NSLP → Site Data: Displays the claims reimbursement request that must be submitted monthly for each month the sponsor operated the program.
