About Summer Feeding Online Application

What does it do?

The Child Nutrition Program (CNP) Online Application is a web based application designed to allow CNP participants to submit their yearly applications for participation and monthly site data sheets to the Department of Education for review and approval.

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) was established to ensure that low-income children continue to receive nutritious meals when school is not in session. Free meals, that meet Federal nutrition guidelines, are provided to all children 18 years old and under at approved SFSP sites in areas with significant concentrations of low-income children.

- SFSP → Forms: Displays the Sponsor, Site Document, Budget and Civil Rights applications that must be submitted yearly by all potential Summer Feeding sponsors for participation in the USDA Summer Food Service Program.
- SFSP → Forms → Site Data: Displays the claims reimbursement request that must be submitted monthly for each month the sponsor operated the program.
