

ACT WorkKeys

The last test administration date for the ACT WorkKeys basic skills assessments of the Alabama Educator Certification Assessment Program (AECAP) was **July 8, 2017**.

If passing scores on all three tests of the ACT WorkKeys (Reading for Information, Writing, and Applied Mathematics) were obtained **on or prior to the last administration**, those scores may be accepted for admission to an Alabama educator preparation program **prior to September 1, 2022**, and for applications for certification received in the Educator Certification Section **prior to September 1, 2022**. Scores from the Alabama Prospective Teacher Test (APTT), administered 2003—2012, and the Alabama Educator Certification Test (AECT), administered 2012—2017, from the ACT WorkKeys will be accepted in partial fulfillment of requirements for certification as long as the certification application is received by the Certification Section of the Office of Teaching and Leading at the ALSDE **on or before August 31, 2022**.

Scores from the ACT WorkKeys basic skills assessments and the Core **cannot** be combined to meet the basic skills assessments requirement. If an individual lacks a passing score on any test of the ACT WorkKeys (Reading, Writing, or Mathematics), he/she will be required to obtain passing scores on all three tests of the Core.

Beginning September 1, 2017, individuals will no longer be able to contact ACT for modifications, test scores, refunds, or to have additional score reports sent. ACT will remove the website affiliated with AECAP. Additionally, they will no longer respond to emails or answer telephone calls regarding AECAP.
