

## Alabama Reading Initiative Summer Learning Sessions

Professional Learning for Alabama educators will be offered in partnership with the 11 Regional Inservice Centers during the summer of 2019. These sessions are designed to enhance the essential knowledge and skills for teaching the reading foundations necessary for all students to be successful readers. Sessions for *Summer 2019* include a three-day ARI module facilitator training designed specifically for ARI reading specialists meeting specific eligibility requirements and a two-day structured literacy training for elementary educators and administrators interested in learning more about multisensory instruction and intervention.

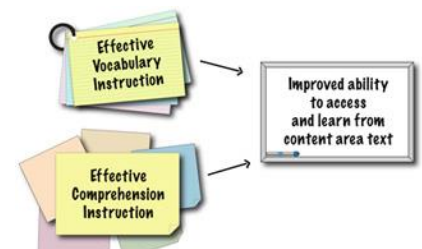
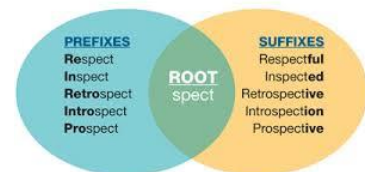
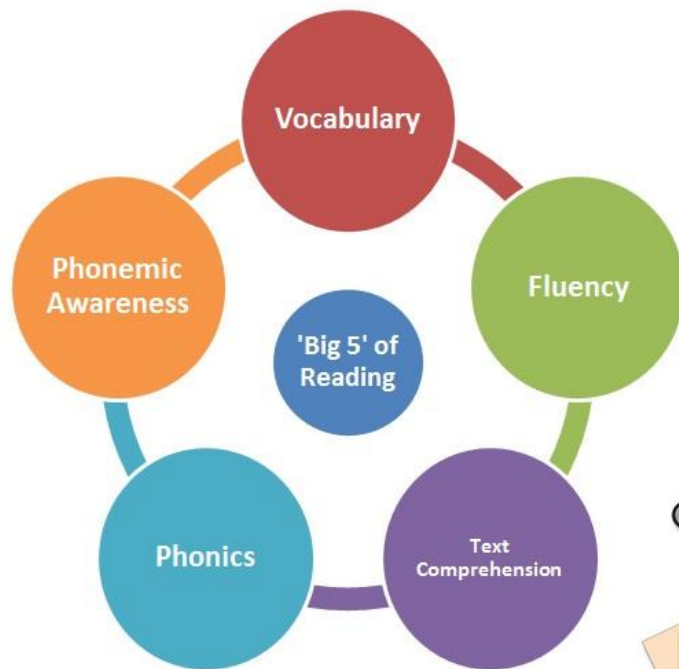
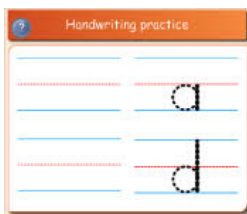
# ARI Structured Literacy Training for Elementary Educators

This summer professional learning is designed for veteran and first-year elementary, intervention, special education, and EL teachers, and elementary administrators who want a deeper understanding of foundational reading instruction. This two-day professional learning session, facilitated by ARI regional staff, will be offered in each inservice region during the Summer of 2019. The training will focus heavily on the systematic, direct, and explicit ways to teach reading utilizing multisensory methods of instruction.
