MEMORANDUM

TO: City and County Superintendents of Education
FROM: Philip C. Cleveland *PCC*
Interim State Superintendent of Education
RE: Window for Reviewing Local Indicator Scoring

All evidence associated with school/local education agency (LEA) local indicators must be uploaded to the AdvancEd Assist platform prior to July 29, 2016. The Research and Development Section of the Alabama State Department of Education will ensure that all schools and LEA scores are entered into the Local Indicator Portal prior to close of business on August 12, 2016. The window for schools and LEAs to verify and request clarification of those scores will begin on August 15, 2016, and end on August 26, 2016.

As stated in the memorandum dated January 15, 2016, the total number of points awarded will be based on the following percentages:

- 25% for providing a measurable baseline for the submitted local indicator
- 25% for providing a measurable goal tied to positive student outcomes
- 50% for meeting the submitted measurable goal (partial points will be awarded if goal is not fully met)
