MEMORANDUM

RE: Round II of Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Allocations

The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) has received its distribution of funds from the *Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act 2021*, which provides an additional allocation for the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief II Funds (ESSER II Funds) to support efforts in creating opportunities to recover learning loss in Alabama.

ESSER II Funds were awarded to Alabama in the same proportion as the state received under Part A of Title I of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965* as amended in Fiscal Year 2020. The total amount allocated to Alabama for the ESSER II Funds is \$899,464,932.

Each district will complete an Alabama Recovery Plan Application for the allocated amount of funds attached. The plan, inclusive of a needs assessment and budget sheet, will be reviewed and funds will be released based on the same format utilized for ESSER I Funds. The application is expected to be released on March 1, 2021. Further details inclusive of allowable categories will be provided upon release of Alabama's Recovery Plan Application.


